full time employee
fixed term employment contract (till 30th of June 2021)

THE TASKS OF A PERSON EMPLOYED AT THIS POSITION WILL INCLUDE:

- conducting scientific research,
- obtaining research grants,
- publishing research results in scientific journals and monographs,
- upgrading research and teaching skills,
- didactic activity,
- developing academic programmes and curricula,
- organization of the teaching process,
- organization of scientific conferences and seminars,
- upgrading professional skills and qualifications.

CANDIDATES MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- medical doctor license with the right to practice the profession,
- obtained PhD in the field of cardiology or genetics,
- English language skills at B2/C1 level,
- showing scientific achievements: at least one full-text publication in the reviewed scientific journal with at least Q2 or scientific achievements with minimum 1.0 IF point, or at least one registered patent application **OR** minimum 1-year work experience at a university with the prospect of obtaining doctoral degree in the next 4 years **OR** participation in scientific students organizations during studies **OR** having aptitude for scientific and teaching work supported by a favourable opinion of the supervisor.

WE OFFER:

- full time contract of employment as an academic teacher for a fixed term of 48 months,
- working at the best medical university in Poland with the status of a research university,
- attractive employee benefits.

COMPETITION PROCEDURE:

- The competition may be entered by candidates who meet the requirements of the Polish Law on Higher Education and Science (requirements referred to art.113) such as:
 - meeting the requirements specified in the above mentioned Act and the statute of MUG,
 - not being punished by disciplinary penalty referred to art. 276 paragraph 1 points 7 and 8 of the above mentioned Act,
 - meeting the requirements referred to in art. 20 clause 1 points 1-3 of the above mentioned Act,
 - confirming that, in case of winning this competition, Medical University of Gdansk will be the candidates' primary place of employment as defined by the above mentioned Act.
- Candidates willing to participate in the competition are to submit the application (all required documents) via the **APPLY** button.
- The deadline for applying is **30/07/2020 at 23.59** - the date and time recorded by the recruitment system is applicable.
- The result of the competition is based on the analysis of the documentation submitted by the candidates.
- The result of the competition will be announced on the University website www.praca.gumed.edu.pl

- The University reserves the right to close the competition without stating any reasons.
- The final decision on employment of a candidate recommended by Competition Committee, is made by the Rector of the Medical University of Gdańsk.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

- a written statement on entering the competition,
- personal questionnaire for candidate applying for employment,
- CV (information on candidate's previous work achievements)
- the list of publications and the information on achieved points (Impact Factor and the scores from the Polish Ministry of Science and Higher Education, the number of citations), and titles of the magazines that have published candidate's scientific papers or articles,
- diploma stating the professional titles obtained by the candidate (along with the supplement),
- professional specialization documents,
- valid license,
- copies of the former employment certifications and confirmation of current employment,
- other documents confirming qualifications and competence for teaching students,
- Candidate's statement on meeting the requirements of the art. 13 Polish Law on Higher Education and Science,
- Candidate's statement to choose the Medical University of Gdansk as their primary place of employment as defined by the Polish Law on Higher Education and Science.
